

BYLAW NO. 108

WHEREAS the Indian Act R.S.C. 1970 c.I-6, as amended, provides that a Band Council may authorize the Minister to make payments out of capital and revenue moneys to persons whose names become deleted from the Band List of the Band; and

WHEREAS the Band has passed Bylaw #107 which permits such authorizations on a per capital basis; and

WHEREAS there is generally confusion with respect to the method of calculating a per capital share; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a By-law of the Sawridge Indian Band as follows:

- 1) For the purpose of By-law #107, which was passed on March 18th, 1988, a one per capita share of the capital and revenue moneys held by her Majesty on behalf of the Band shall be calculated by dividing the number which is equal to the number of names which appeared on the Band List on the day upon which a members name was removed from the Band List immediately prior to the removal of that name, into the total of all of the capital and revenue moneys held by her Majesty on behalf of the Band on the day on which the members name was removed from the Band List immediately prior to the removal of that name.
- 2) This By-law shall have effect from March 18th, 1988.
- 3) In the case of multiple removals of names on the same date, the calculation set out in paragraph 1 shall be made such that each person removed on the same date receives a per capita share equal to the share calculated for the first name removed on that day.

This By-law duly read and passed at a duly convened and constituted meeting of the Sawridge Indian Band Council this 27th day of JULY, 1988.
