## BY-LAW NO. 107

WHEREAS the <u>Indian Act</u>, R.S.C. 1970, c. I-6, as amended, provides that a Band council may authorize the Minister to make payments out of capital or revenue moneys to persons whose names become deleted from the Band List of the Band;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Sawridge Indian Band as follows:

- 1. That the Minister is hereby authorized to make such payments out of capital or revenue moneys as the Band Council may direct to any person whose name appears on the Sawridge Band List in accordance with its membership rules and whose name is subsequently deleted from the Band List in accordance with its membership rules.
- 2. When the Minister is directed to make a payment by the Band Council, the amount payable shall be equal to one per capita share of the capital and revenue moneys held by her Majesty on behalf of the Band.
- 3. When the Minister is directed to make a payment by the Band Council, the Minister shall prior to making such payment deduct from the amount payable as calculated in paragraph 2 an amount equal to any and all debts including interest owed to the Band by the person for whose account the money is to be paid. The Minister shall pay the amount deducted to the Band.
